Using BT2002 with SP1 on W2K server. I created a file receive function that is supposed to poll the (\*.xml) files on a file share on our LAN. But the file receive function is being disabled by the BTS with the following error in the event log. The account, the BizTalk Messaging Service is running under, has full control on the remote file share.
